Orchards Room:

Lisa, Jodie and Rachel have started off the new year with lots of Mindfulness activities. Lisa is currently completing a qualification to teach yoga and Mindfulness to both adults and children which we are taking full advantage of! Over the coming weeks Lisa will be putting her skills to practice and the children will start their mindfulness and yoga programme. They are also looking at animals and in particular pets. Forest School

Forest school continues to be hugely popular and the activities provided by the staff are allowing the children to learn new skills and embrace our outdoor environment. The children are learning about the wildlife and in particular the birds so they really enjoyed making the bird food for them. Due to the very muddy conditions and needing to rest our grass area, for the next few weeks forest school will be held on the patio area where the children will continue to have access to all the opportunities previously available. The weather is looking like we will be seeing some minus conditions so please make sure your child comes suitably dressed for Forest School. The children will need plenty of warm layers as well as hats and gloves! We also ask that these items are clearly named so we can return them at the end of the day.
