New Government Funding

As you are all aware the government have announced a new funding plan for Early Years Settings where all children will be funded from the age of 9 months. You will have received information from Tina regarding the funding and how this will work for the setting. We are still in the process of trying to navigate this so please bear with us. As you know the cost of living has increased significantly, and the minimum wage is due to go up in April so we need to consider this when making our decisions.

New door system

Firstly, the team and I would like to thank you for your co-operation with the new door system in the afternoons. Due to the increase in numbers at preschool and also the varied collection times, we were finding the afternoon circle times were becoming increasingly disruptive for the children. By having set collection times the staff can make sure that all children leaving at these points are ready. We do understand that there maybe times where you will need to collect your child before 3:00 or 3:30 so please let a member of staff know at drop off and we will ensure that we accommodate this.

Easter craft stay and play.

We would like to invite you to an Easter Stay and Play on Thursday 21st March. This will be from 1:45-2:45 and will finish with an Easter Bonnet Parade. There will be crafts available for you to do with your child and a chance for a cuppa and a chat with other parents! There will be Easter Bonnet resources available on the day but if you would like to make one at home and bring it in then we will look forward to seeing the creations! The children will then take part in a parade outside (Weather permitting!) There may even be some tasty treats too. If your child doesn't normally attend on a Thursday, then you are more than welcome to still join us.

Tapestry Competition

During the Easter holidays get your memories sent into tapestry to be entered in our prize draw! Tapestry is a fabulous tool to share experiences between preschool and home. The children love being able to show their friends their pictures and it's a great communicative tool for them to talk about their experiences.
