Planning for the next half term

This half term we will be using several different hooks for our learning opportunities. We will be focusing on introducing the children to recycling and will be adding to this each week with different activities. We will also be using events, such as, Pancake Day, Mother's Day and Easter to extend and secure children's learning and development. Story Choices Study

Last term the children in their pre-school year took part in a vocabulary-based screening session for the 'Story Choices' study. The study is interested in which approach to planning leads to the most improvement in children's language when reading stories. Following the screening we have now been asked to follow a child led/responsive story time for 12 weeks. In this approach, Educators ask children to select the book for the daily group reading session or actively involve them in the book selection process. While reading, the questions and discussion points occur spontaneously. We look forward to sharing the findings of the study with you in future months.
